Containers

Aluminum, steel, tin cans
Beer, wine, liquor bottles
Food jars
Glass jars
Narrow neck plastic bottles
and jugs, milk & water jugs
(Regardless of number on bottom)
Pie tins
Yogurt cups

Paper

Newspapers and inserts
Mail, office & school paper
Magazines, catalogs
Brown grocery bags
Phone books
Shredded paper
(In closed paper bags)
Cereal, cracker, pasta boxes
Cardboard, flattened
Shoe boxes, gift boxes
Pop and beer boxes
Electronics boxes

DO NOT INCLUDE

Auto, mirror or tinted glass
Blueprints, transparencies
Carbon paper
Carpeting
Clothing
Hazardous waste or containers
Crystal glassware
Disposable diapers
Egg carton boxes
Foil containers
Light bulbs
Metal or steel objects such as
nails, wire, hangers or case
strapping
Paper towels, napkins, tissue
Pet-soiled paper
Photos, photographic paper
Plastic bags
Pyrex, heat-resistant ovenware
Rubber-type materials, latex
Self-adhesive labels
Styrofoam
Toys
Wax coated boxes

IMPORTANT...

Rinse food from containers
Remove caps and lids
(No need to remove labels)
Break down large items

Cardboard

Flatten cardboard & boxes
*Cardboard boxes should be
flattened and placed next to the
waste receptacle.*
