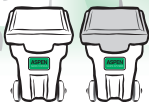

Instructions

Please have your carts out by 6:00 am.

Place these items together in your cart

Plastic

Bottles, containers, tubs and lids smaller than 3 gallons (#1-#5, #7)

Containers

Aluminum, steel, tin cans
Beer, wine, liquor bottles
Food jars
Glass jars
Milk & water jugs
Pie tins
Plastic bottles and jugs

Paper

Brown grocery bags
Cardboard, flattened
Cereal, cracker, pasta boxes
Electronics boxes
Mail, office & school paper
Magazines, catalogs
Milk cartons and juice boxes
Newspapers and inserts
Phone books, books
Pop and beer boxes
Shoe boxes, gift boxes
Shredded paper

(In closed paper bags)

DO NOT INCLUDE

Auto, mirror or tinted glass
Blueprints, transparencies
Carbon paper
Carpeting
Clothing
Crystal glassware
Disposable diapers
Egg cartons
Hazardous waste or containers
Light bulbs
Medical waste
Metal or steel objects such as nails, wire, hangers or case strapping
Paper towels, napkins, tissue
Pet-soiled paper
Photos, photographic paper
Pizza boxes
Plastic bags
Pyrex, heat-resistant ovenware
Rubber-type materials, latex
Self-adhesive labels
Styrofoam
Toys
Wax coated boxes

IMPORTANT

Rinse food from containers
Remove caps and lids
(No need to remove labels)
Break down large items

Flatten cardboard & boxes

Extra cardboard boxes can be flattened and tied into bundles no more than 3 ft. long by 3 ft. wide by 1 ft. tall and placed next to your cart.
